

The EVCC Board of Directors is thrilled to announce the new re-opening guidelines that will go into effect **Saturday June 19, 2021** for the use of our facilities until further notice.

Our community center hours will be from 8 am to 8 pm **daily**.

A) Masks will be required for partially or unvaccinated members & guests.

B) No reservations required for the pool, spa, tennis or pickleball.

C) The maximum number of guests allowed for the swimming pool area is seven (7) per household. Guests must be accompanied by a member at all times. Large group reservations will not be allowed and Guest Cards will not be issued at this time.

D) The maximum number of guests for tennis and pickleball is three (3) per household.

E) The BBQs and outdoor small kitchen will be available by reservation only. Maximum of two (2) hours per household.

F) The ball machine will be available for use by reservation (\$5 fee per hour)

G) The clubhouse will be available for use for scheduled HOA board and ARC meetings during regular facility hours.

H) The clubhouse will be available for rental for private use during regular facility hours. In addition to the room rental agreement, the "Notice to Enter the EVCC Facilities at your Own Risk" agreement is required.

I) Stretch Class will be allowed to use the clubhouse during their regular scheduled days and time.

J) The next scheduled Happy Hour will take place on Friday July 16 from 6 to 8 pm.
Special theme: Bingo Night!

K) The library is fully open.

L) Sanitation will continue.

Reminder! Summer is here and it's our busiest time of the year! General Facility Rules -

- a) No glass containers allowed in the pool or tennis courts areas
- b) No large floating devices during periods of busy use
- c) Diaper-aged children must wear a swim diaper when in the pool or spa. Swim diapers can be purchased at the office for \$1.00
- d) Please be aware of lap swimmers when in the pool, especially during periods of busy use
