# APPROVAL OF PREVIOUS MEETING MINUTES

Upon a motion duly made, seconded, and unanimously carried, the Board approved the January 18, 2022, regular meeting minutes as written. (Armstrong/Hebert). Garry Denlinger abstained.

Upon a motion duly made, seconded, and unanimously carried, the Board approved rock to be installed around the entrance sign at the cost of \$850.00. (Chenet/Kersey)

Facilities/Maintenance

Mr. Hebert reviewed the report for Maintenance. He shared his approval of the sign painting. The Board discussed the following projects: fence, screening, trellis, and termite damage and agreed to put all on hold. The Board discussed the addition of a pickleball court.

Upon a motion duly made, seconded, and unanimously carried, the Board authorized the conversion of tennis court #4 to four pickleball courts at a cost not to exceed \$14,000.00. (Hebert/Kersey)

Mr. Hebert reviewed the trellis on the north side of the property. He said we will need a new ARC request.

The Board discussed the termite damage and we will be getting bids on the wood damage.

Mrs. Green said that happy hour will be held and masks will be recommended. The Board discussed the March 4<sup>th</sup> and March 18<sup>th</sup> happy hour. March 4<sup>th</sup> will be hosted by David Hebert.
